

- ▶ Develop home/school partnership




Registration and Attendance

Leave of absence form available on website for requests for planned absence during school time.




Student Planner

- ▶ Homework in Year 7 is designed to develop your independent learning skills which will be useful in your time at Carre's Grammar School and beyond.
- ▶ You will receive formal set homework
- ▶ On days where you have not been set homework by your teacher you will be expected to complete independent learning activities.

- ▶ All students are expected to have the basic equipment for school (pen, pencil, planner)
- ▶ Could parent/carers please name your child's personal belongings and clothing, so items can be returned to the correct owner if misplaced.
