



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
Interests

I have recently returned to running after quite a long break. My claim to fame is that I ran The London Marathon in 2013 in 4 hours 35 minutes.




I have a dog called Benji (a Goldendoodle) who likes going for long walks and annoying other dogs.

 - ▶ Develop home/school partnership
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

Use it every day to record homework.


Useful for messages between home/school.


But I don't have any homework set!
