Although choices are not set in stone at this point, we use the information to build our Sixth Form option blocks, so that we can endeavour to meet likely student demand for different courses. Students should put their application form in the box outside the Key Stage 5 office (in the library), regardless of which school they wish to base at, as they are processed centrally.

### Further Guidance

Students are in the process of having 1:1 Career's meetings where they can explore their options further, and all students will have a 1:1 counselling meeting with a member of the Sixth Form team after Christmas, where we can discuss the application and their options to ensure they have made the most appropriate choices for them to achieve their potential.
