### *Core Concept:*

- Respect for each other
- Working together

### *Mutual Respect in Music:*

- We respect others' views in class discussion
- We show appreciation of others' performances
- We work together on group performances and compositions

## The Rule of Law

### *Core Concept:*

- Understanding rules and why they are important
- Following rules to develop order

### *The Rule of Law in Music:*

- We understand the importance of following rules in learning and caring for an instrument and in performance situations
- We understand the need for discipline when performing on instruments and singing
- We understand that there are different conventions of creating and performing music
- We understand the importance of copyright law and the importance of not plagiarising the work of others

# British Values in Music

## Tolerance of Different Faiths and Beliefs

### *Core Concept:*

- Learning about different faiths and cultures
- Listen to other viewpoints
- Learning about diversity

### *Tolerance of Different Faiths and Beliefs in Music:*

- We learn to appreciate that people have different tastes in music and that we should be tolerant of their opinions
- Music can help us to learn about different cultures and beliefs, through their music
- The study of Music can broaden and diversify our understanding of other people

## Democracy

### *Core Concept:*

- Making decisions together
- The right to an opinion/voice

### *Democracy in Music:*

- We encourage students to develop their own tastes in Music and be able to explain their choices
- Students are encouraged to respect the opinions of others
- We involve everyone in class discussion and ensure that everyone has the right to a view

## Individual Liberty

### *Core Concept:*

- Freedom of speech for all
- The right to make our own choices

### *Individual Liberty in Music:*

- We understand the importance of the creative process in Music composition
- We appreciate that Music critics might express different opinions about a piece of music
- Students are encouraged to develop their own musical styles in composition
